



# BMW GOLF CUP

## TOURNAMENT RULES

### RULES & REGULATIONS

• **Play Format :**

Stroke Play (18 Holes)

• **Tee-off**

Men : White Tee  
Ladies : Red Tee

• **Tournament Flights and Handicap**

Men Flight 1 : Handicap 0-12  
Men Flight 2 : Handicap 13-28  
Ladies Flight : Handicap 0-28

• **Scoring System :** 36 System & Stableford

The scoring system is as follows : 36 System is used to find Golfer's handicap then use the handicap to calculate Stableford points.

**Stableford Point Index:**

- 2 or more over Adjusted par - 0 points
- 1 over Adjusted par - 1 points
- Adjusted Par - 2 points
- 1 under Adjusted par - 3 points
- 2 under Adjusted par - 4 points
- 3 under Adjusted par - 5 points
- And so on...

Par for each hole will be adjusted according to golfer handicap and golf course hole difficulty handicap scale.

**For example :**

- If one golfer has a handicap of 7 then hole difficulty scale of 1 to 7 will be added 1 stroke to original hole par ( Par 3 will be 4, Par 4 will be 5 and so on...).
- If golfer has handicap of 18 then every hole will be added 1 stroke to original par.
- If golfer has a handicap of 24 then holes' handicap scale of 1 to 6 will have 2 strokes added to par and the rest will have 1 stroke added to par.
- Use the scoring system table from above to calculate point for every hole then sum up all point to get each golfer total net point score.
- Golfer who gets the most point will be the winner in his or her flight category.

• **Rules, Qualification, and Decision**

- Employees of BMW (Thailand) Co., Ltd. and BMW Golf Cup 2021 event, which are employees, dealers, organizers, suppliers, as well as all relatives of the above mentioned, are permitted to take part in the qualifying tournaments; however, they are not officially scored and are therefore unable to qualify for the National Final and World Final. In compliance with BMW's policy, this rule also applies to members of the media and members of partnering organizations invited by BMW.
- BMW Golf Cup is an amateur tournament.

- Professional golfer is prohibited to participate BMW Golf Cup tournament. If any professional golfer is allowed to participate the tournament in special case, such professional golfer is not eligible for any prize.
- No player is permitted to participate in more than one tournament.
  - The winner will be considered from the stable ford points.
  - In the event of a tie, the player whose handicap is lower will be the winner. In the event that the handicap is the same, the golfer with lower gross score will be the winner. In the event that gross score is still equal, the retrogression count back will commence from the 18th hole.
  - The winners of the individual categories qualify for the national final. If a qualifying player is unable to take part in the national final, the next best-scoring player in the qualifying tournament then takes the place.
  - Only BMW car owner and client of specific authorized dealer will eligible to qualify to the National Final round.
  - The winners in each of the three categories (Men A/B, Women) of the National Final qualify to take part in the world final.
  - BMW Golf Cup World Final is a one in a life time experience, therefore golfer who ever participated in the World Final will not eligible to take part in the World Final again.
  - Each score card needs signature of both Player and Marker before submission.
  - Please write only numbers, not any symbols in score card.
  - Please strictly follow local and standard rules of golf course.
  - Scorecard not submitted within 30 minutes after completion of round will be considered as "NON RETURNED".
  - In case of any urgent accidents or players cannot finish 18 holes, scoring will be judged by the tournament committee.
  - If any participant would like to contest their tournament score, submissions must be made with the tournament officials within 30 minutes of the round completion. All judgments are final.
  - All prizes will be awarded to amateur golfers only
  - Only Golfers aged 18 years or over on the tournament day are eligible to advance to National Final.
  - Golfers who eligible to qualify to the National Final must hold an amateur status according to Thailand Golf Association. (www.tga.or.th/)
  - Any player found to be violating the terms of the competition will be disqualified from taking part.

• **Trophy Prizes**

Winner : Men Flight 1, Men Flight 2, and Ladies Flight  
Runner up: Men Flight 1, Men Flight 2, and Ladies Flight
